# Why Are We Here?



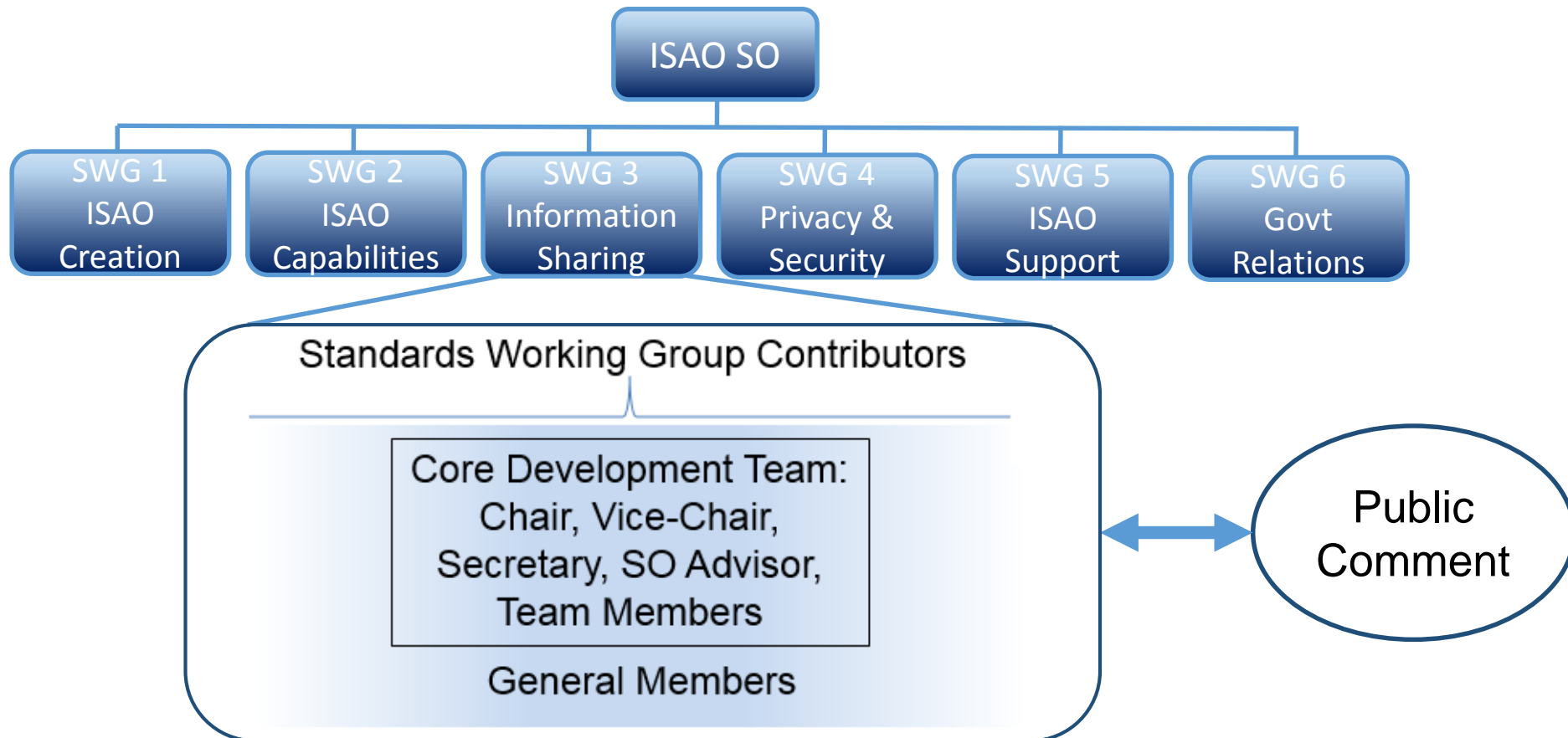
“The cyber threat is one of the most serious economic and national security challenges we face as a Nation.”

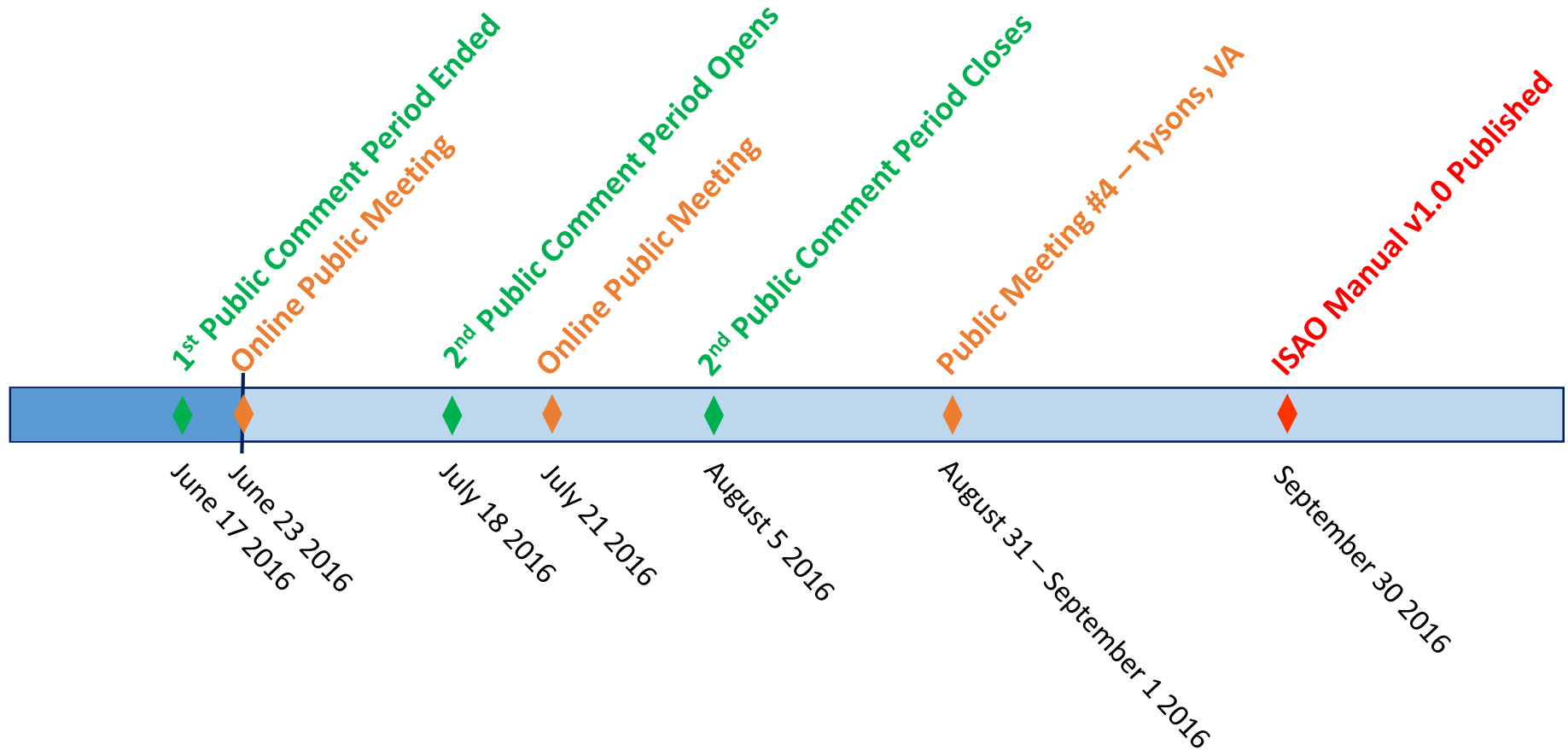
